- consult with the officer in charge on plans and priorities
- give direction to the officer in charge on implementing the yearly plan
- appoint a Public Complaints Director

COMMISSIONS/COMMITTEES

Police Commission

Prepares a budget

Establishes policies for the police service

May conduct an inquiry

Hires a chief of police as ratified by Council

May terminate chief of police

Policing Committee

Oversees the Municipal Policing Agreement

Assists in selection of officer in charge

Community Advisory Committee

Purpose

- Advises officer in charge on policing concerns and problems in the community
- Terms of reference and membership decided by officer in charge
- Members appointed by officer in charge

Funding

Municipal Policing Assistance Grant

- Towns and cities with a population from 5,001 to 20,000 receive a \$200,000 base payment plus an additional \$8.00 per capita.
- Cities and urban service areas with a population from 20,001 to 100,000 receive greater of \$16 per capita or a \$100,000 base payment plus \$14.00 per capita.
- Cities with a population over 100,000 receive grants of \$16.00 per capita.

Funding

MPAG Assists with Municipal Responsibility

- Own/Regional Police Service – 100% of cost
- RCMP Contract over 15,000 population – 90% of contract cost
- RCMP Contract under 15,000 population – 70% of contract cost
