- Administration to move forward with the implementation of polling, development of creative and engagement of a media consultant to leverage media for a public campaign.
- The following key messages to be used in the public campaign:
 1. Municipalities are responsible for providing the sidewalks, roads, bridges, water systems, libraries, recreational centres, ambulance services, policing.
 2. Not all the money paid in property taxes from citizens and businesses stays in their community.
 3. That only 8 cents of every tax dollar a citizen pays stays within the community.
