Collaborative Governance Initiative

The Collaborative Governance Initiative (CGI) can be undertaken internally or intermunicipally as a preventative approach to dispute resolution. It helps municipalities develop collaborative protocols and processes to avert conflict escalations and to allow municipalities to rely on an agreed-upon process for collaborative engagement.

Let's Resolve: Dispute Resolution Workshops

Municipal staff and elected officials are encouraged to take part in the "Let's Resolve" dispute resolution training program sponsored by AUMA, AAMDC, and Alberta Municipal Affairs. The program offers hands on learning opportunities through courses designed to build municipal capacity in dispute resolution and support local solutions to local issues.

Peer Network

The Peer Network is a more formal way to offer advice, suggest alternatives and provide short-term assistance to help you resolve issues.

Regional Collaboration Program (RCP)

The RCP is to improve the viability and long-term sustainability of municipalities through strategic activities related to regional collaboration and capacity building.
