Building an IT & data assets inventory

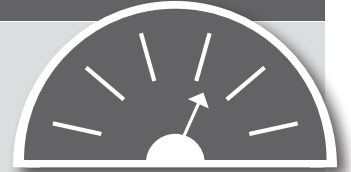
Without an understanding of your information assets and their importance, it's almost impossible to make strategic cybersecurity decisions.

Understanding your risk profile

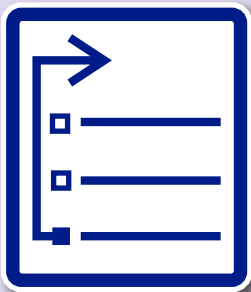

You can identify the most unacceptable risks and channel resources toward them rather than toward less likely or less damaging risks.

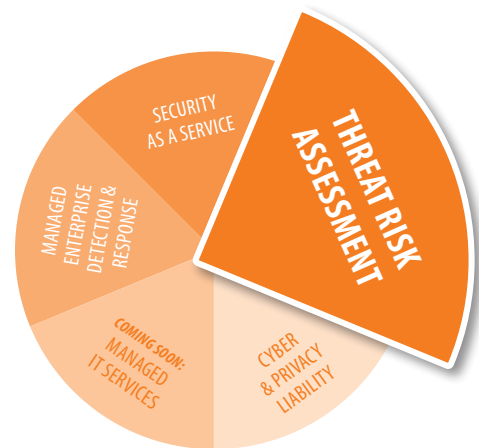


Identifying & reducing vulnerabilities
