Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR)

Packaging and Paper/Hazardous and Special Products

- Alberta Municipalities has advocated for an EPR packaging and paper program since 2019.
- Alberta Environment and Parks is developing EPR regulations for packaging and paper and hazardous and special products.
- Our focus in 2022 is on transitioning municipal services to EPR programs once the regulations are passed.



Broadband

- Budget 2022 contained \$390 million in funding over the next four years to improve broadband service in Alberta.
- If matching federal dollars can be secured, the total investment will be \$780 million
- Alberta Municipalities passed a resolution calling on the province to release a broadband strategy and they have delivered.



Municipal Autonomy

Jason Kenney - July 2020

"We've said we'll respect the decision of municipalities in this regard. We think these decisions are better taken locally...so we think a one-size-fits-all approach for a huge, vast, diverse province doesn't make sense.

Jason Kenney – March 2022

"We are concerned that a patchwork of sperate policies across the province could just lead to greater division, confusions, enforcement difficulty with no compelling public health rationale."



Prompt Payment

- The provincial government proclaimed the Construction Lien and Prompt Payment Act and accompanying regulations at the end of February.
 - They will come into effect on August 29, 2022.
- This new Act replaces the outdated *Builders' Lien Act* and establishes legislated timelines for both issuing invoices and payment of invoices.
- The regulations establish a system to adjudicate payment disputes.


